Provincial Team Selection Criteria

(Approved at 2005 AGM)

1. Senior Teams

The best total out of 100 will be taken from the highest aggregate from all the Open Championships on provincial level attended plus the league shoots for each individual event that makes up the Big Bore Handgun aggregate (events 1,2,3 & 4), Small Bore Handgun aggregate (events 5,6,7 & 8), Field Pistol aggregate (events 9 & 10), Handgun Standing aggregate (events 3,7,9 & 10), Big Bore Rifle aggregate (events 11 & 12), Small Bore Rifle aggregate (events 13 & 14) and Small Bore Rifle Open Sights Aggregate (events 20 & 21).

This means that:

- The individual events from the highest aggregate score from all the Open Championships on provincial level will count out of 40 towards each individual event;
and
- The three highest scores per event taken from all the league shoots (20 shots per event per league shoot) will count out of 60 towards each individual event.

The individual event scores calculated from the above will be used to compile a Big Bore Handgun, Small Bore Handgun, Field Pistol, Handgun Standing, Big Bore Rifle, Small Bore Rifle and Small Bore Rifle Open Sights Aggregate for each competitor. The aggregate scores will be used to select the three member provincial senior teams to compete at the SA National Championships.

2. Junior Teams

The best total out of 60 will be taken from the highest aggregate from all the Open Championships on provincial level attended plus the best league shoot for each individual event that makes up the Small Bore Handgun aggregate (events 5,6,7 & 8), Small Bore Rifle aggregate (events 13 & 14) and Small Bore Rifle Open Sights aggregate (events 20 & 21)

or

The best total out of 60 will be taken for each event from the three best league shoots.

This means that:

- The individual events from the highest aggregate score from all the Open Championships on provincial level will count out of 40 towards each individual event and the best league score in the individual event will be added to count out of 60 towards each individual event,
or
- The three highest scores per event taken from all the league shoots (20 shots per event per league shoot) will count out of 60 towards each individual event.

The individual event scores calculated from the above will be used to compile a Small Bore Handgun, Small Bore Rifle and Small Bore Rifle Open Sights Aggregate for each competitor. The aggregate scores will be used to select the three member provincial junior teams to compete at the SA National Championships.

3. General

- The criteria set the number of league shoots that must be attended. If a senior member only attends two league shoots, but manages a higher aggregate score than a member that participated in the required three league shoots, the member that complied with all the criteria and attended all the required league shoots, must be given preference in the selection.
- The criteria set the events that must be participated in per aggregate. If a member only shoots three out of four events for a four event aggregate, but manages a higher aggregate score than a member that participated in all the events for the aggregate, the member that complied with all the criteria and participated in all the events, must be given preference in the selection.
- The selection committee may:
 - Select teams with fewer members than required for the team;
 - Select an individual that has previously been awarded provincial colours, but does not qualify now, to be included in a team;
 - In conjunction with other provinces, select a combined team to represent the provinces.

4. Notes

1. *Open Championships on provincial level: This will exclude all other Championships on national and international level like the IMSSU World Championships, Africa Continental Championships, SA National Championships and SA Trials, but includes SAMSSA sanctioned matches like the WP Classic.*
2. *Open Championships on provincial level will include all championships on provincial level since the last SA Nationals up to the last one before the teams are selected. Similarly, the leagues taken into account will include this same period.*
3. *For league shoots it is not necessary to shoot complete aggregates at every league, e.g. for four event aggregates a competitor may spread the events across league shoots over the league period. When the aggregates are summarized at the end of the period, there must however be the required number of scores for each of the aggregate events required for the aggregate that is needed for selection purposes.*
4. *Teams may be selected for combination of the IMSSU aggregates, e.g. Big Bore and Small Bore 4 Rifle aggregate (events 11, 12, 13 & 14) and Small Bore Rifle Any Sights aggregate (events 13, 14, 20 & 21). Championship and league participation requirements will be the same as above.*
5. *Teams may be selected for SAMSSA approved teams. Championship and league participation requirements will be the same as above.*
6. *Individuals may be selected to represent the province in individual events and/or individual aggregates. Championship and league participation requirements will be the same as above.*
